



# NOTES FOR SCORERS 2021/22 #1

## MATCH DAY SCORING

The Management Committee strongly recommends that scorers follow a number of basic rules.

1. Scorers use a uniform code for scoring wides, no balls, byes & leg byes.

- + Wides & any runs score as all wides
- No balls – 1 no ball extra + runs not off the bat scored as byes or leg byes (depends on umpires call); runs off the bat are scored to the batter.

2. Scorers know who the bowler is.
3. Scorers know who the wicketkeeper is.
4. When there has been a catch / run out & you (or someone from your team does not know or is unsure of the fielder(s) involved, **ask the question** “name of fielder?”
5. Scorers confirm scores with each other on a regular basis.
6. Scorers tally all bowlers stats before umpires sign off on the result (if batting + sundries does not equal bowler runs + byes/leg byes sort it out before you leave the ground)  
As a last resort use the bowling stats for the score.



**The Management Committee strongly recommends that you do not leave the ground at the completion of the match without all the above details being recorded in the scorebook(s)**

This applies to both teams but is especially important to the home team.
